This Deed made this 16th day of November in the year 1864 by me
Margaret Shane. Witnesseth. Whereas by a decree of the Circuit Court
for Allegany County as a Court of Equity, passed on the 19th day of No-
vember 1864 in the case of William Arnold and others vs Margaret
Shane and others, the real estate in the proceedings mentioned was
decreed to be sold and Thomas Doremson appointed Trustee to sell the
same, and did sell unto Zacariah Johnson all that lot of ground
on the west side of Fulton Street in the town of Cumberland, alle-
gany County, Maryland known as Lot number nine in books addi-
tion to said town of Cumberland, which is described in the deed
from said Trustee, to said Johnson dated the 10th day of November
1864 and I authorized said Trustee to see the same clear of the debt
which I had therein, and waived said debt for the benefit of my
deceased husband's creditors.

That in consideration of four hundred dollars, the said Ira Burton
and Mariah his wife, and William McKenzie, and Margaret A. his
wife, do grant unto Moses McKenzie of said County and State, the
ten undivided sixth parts in and to all those three several tracts or
parcels of Land, lying and being in said County, and State called

"Lilley of the Valley" Addition to Lilley of the Valley" and
"Williams Dale" which were sold and conveyed to — — — Jesse Mc-
Kenzie by William Myers by deed bearing date the 11th day of October
1826. and recorded in Lib. A.B. W.C. folio 276. 277. & 278. one of the

At the request of Michael Gannon this
Deed Lease was recorded Nov 14th 1864,
This Lease, made this sixteenth day of September, in the year eighteen hun-
dred and sixty four, between William Shaw and Michael Gannon both
of Allegany County, and State of Maryland.

Witnesseth that the said
William Shaw doth Lease unto the said Michael Gannon his personal
representations and assigns all that ^{house} half Lot. No. 5 in the town of Barton
on North Rail Road Street where the said Gannon now resides, also with
the said House and lot to have a small piece of ground in the rear
aw. on the line of the fence, at any such place of point as Shaw may
designate, and lay off, but not to exceed twenty feet by thirty feet, for
to build a stable, or stables upon, all to have for the term of ten years.
Beginning on this the sixteenth day of September eighteen hundred
and sixty four, and ending, and to end, on the sixteenth day of
September eighteen hundred and seventy four, the said Michael
Gannon paying therefor the sum of Fifty five dollars per annum
payable, and to be paid as follows, viz: that is to say the sum of
twenty two dollars and fifty cents, on the sixteenth day of March
1865, and sum of twenty two dollars and fifty cents, on the sixteenth
day of September 1865, and the further sum or sums of twenty two
dollars and fifty cents on each and every sixteenth day of March
September in each and every year thereafter for and during the
whole term of ten years, as above, and the said Shaw is also to
